

MENTORING WORKSHOP

Thursday, April 25, 2002 – 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Location: In Winnipeg (To be determined)

Overview:

This workshop provides frameworks for implementing and operating a mentoring program in an organization, and for encouraging the development of mentoring as an integral part of an organization's culture. The workshop approach will be interactive and hands-on.

The workshop facilitator will share the lessons learned from research in workplace mentoring, and participants will be encouraged to draw on their own experience to create a plan for implementing or improving the use of mentoring in their workplaces.

Participants will learn to:

- Define and describe the more popular approaches to mentoring
- Assess the readiness of their organizations for mentoring
- Select a mentoring approach that is attuned to their organization's culture
- Develop the tools needed to implement mentoring
- Design an effective mentoring pilot
- Identify and deal with the most common barriers to mentoring
- Select and "match" mentors and mentees
- Identify and foster the skills of great mentors
- Measure the results produced by mentoring
