Ergonomics

Ergonomics is a field of knowledge about human capabilities and the interaction between people and work. This knowledge is used to make jobs easier, safer, more comfortable and performed with less error. Ergonomics is generally associated with musculoskeletal injuries such as sprains and strains, overuse injuries, repetitive strain injuries, and cumulative trauma disorders.

Presenter: Andrew Dolhy, Ergonomic Consultant

Andrew Dolhy is an ergonomic consultant who has worked in private industry and for Manitoba Labour, Workplace Safety and Health. Andrew has performed over 130 assessments in 57 different workplaces and delivered over 40 educational presentations. He has a BSc. Degree in Hons. Kinesiology – Co-op Program from the University of Waterloo and a certificate in Business Management from Red River College.
